Staff

Teachers are passionate and truly enjoy working with children. They respect each child, and their various learning styles, encouraging them to be active participants in learning. Developmentally appropriate programming and behaviour management techniques encourage social, emotional, intellectual and physical development. Positive reinforcement, logical consequences, redirection and modelling are used to guide children in safe and socially acceptable interactions.
